

Consent to the processing of personal data

Since personal data is processed in connection with the completion of the contact form on the website www.drontex.eu (hereinafter referred to as the "contact form"), we would like to provide you, as the data subject, with information about the conditions for processing personal data and your rights under Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (hereinafter referred to as the "Regulation"). At the same time, we would like to assure you that the proper processing of your personal data as data subjects is important to us and their protection is a matter of course.

1. Identification data of the controller

The controller of the information systems in which your personal data are processed is **AltTag Media s.r.o.**, with its registered office at Sabinovská 15800/3B, 821 03 Bratislava - Ružinov, Slovak Republic, ID No.: 46168974, registered in the Commercial Register of the District Court Bratislava I, Section Sro, File No. 73380/B (hereinafter referred to as the "Controller").

2. Purpose of the processing of personal data

3. Source of personal data processed

4. Legal basis for the processing of personal data

5. List of personal data processed

6. Categories of data subjects

The categories of data subjects are the persons who have filled in the contact form.

7. Eligible persons

An authorised person is a natural person who comes into contact with your personal data with the controller in the course of the performance of his or her duties or a similar relationship based, for

example, on a mandate, appointment, election or in the exercise of an official function, and who carries out the processing operations with personal data specified by the controller. As part of its obligation, the controller has instructed all authorised persons in the scope of their powers, permitted activities and the conditions for processing personal data.

8. Conditions for the disposal of personal data

We will retain your personal data for the period strictly necessary to carry out the communication in question with you, but no longer than three months after the last contact with you. We will retain your personal data until the expiry of the consent period or until the consent is withdrawn, whichever is earlier. After the consent period has expired or the consent has been withdrawn, the data will be disposed of (deleted).

1. Identifying data of the operator

6. Categories of data subjects

7. Eligible persons

Withdrawal of consent to receive the newsletter is without prejudice to any other consents you may have given to the controller.

10. Disclosure of personal data

We do not disclose your personal data.

11. Cross-border transfer of personal data

Your personal data may be subject to cross-border processing or transfer. However, your personal data is processed exclusively within the territory of the Slovak Republic in accordance with the laws in force in that territory.

12. Profiling and automated decision-making in the processing of personal data

Your personal data is not used for profiling or any other form of automated decision-making.

Rights of the data subject

o Right to withdraw consent

You have the right to withdraw your consent at any time. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent prior to its withdrawal.

o Right of access

Upon request, you have the right to be provided with a copy of the personal data we hold about you, as well as information about how we use your personal data.

o Right to rectification

If you believe that the information we hold is inaccurate, incomplete or out of date, please do not hesitate to ask us to correct, update or complete the information.

o Right to erasure ('right to be forgotten')

You have the right to ask us to erase your personal data, for example, if the personal data we have collected about you is no longer necessary for the fulfilment of the original purpose of the processing. However, your right must be considered in the light of all the relevant circumstances. For example, we may have certain legal and regulatory obligations which mean that we may not be able to comply with your request.

o Right to restriction of processing

In certain circumstances, you are entitled to ask us to stop using your personal data. These include, for example, where you think that the personal data we hold about you may be incorrect or where you think that we no longer need to use your personal data.

o Right to data portability

In certain circumstances, you have the right to ask us to transfer the personal data you have provided to us to another third party of your choice. However, the right to portability only applies to personal data that we have obtained from you on the basis of consent or on the basis of a contract to which you are a party.

o Right to object

You have the right to object to processing based on our legitimate interests. If we do not have a compelling legitimate ground for processing and you object, we will no longer process your personal data.
